- NAME : I. The name of the Society shall be the Society of the Bridgettine Sisters.
- OFFICE : II. The principal office of the Society will be situated in the State of Karnataka. Its present address is No.10, Brunton Road, Bangalore 560 025.
- OBJECTS : III. The objects for which the Society is established are :
- The promotion of education, science and literature, the diffusion of useful knowledge, training in handicrafts, vocational education, medical relief and charitably purposes.
 - The provisions and maintenance of schools including teachers training and working girls hostels, boarding establishments, social centre or any similar institutions.
 - The training and maintenance of the personnel thereof to be in charge of the different institutions, the supply of books and literature, furniture and all other necessities incidental to the carrying out of its objects and the adoption of other measures and means that may seem

Membership

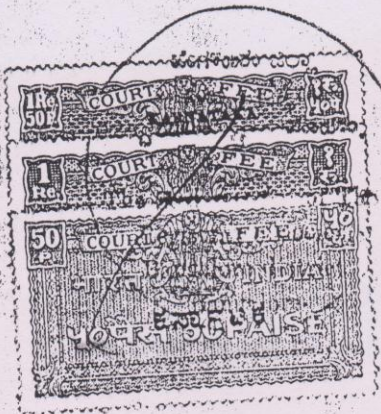
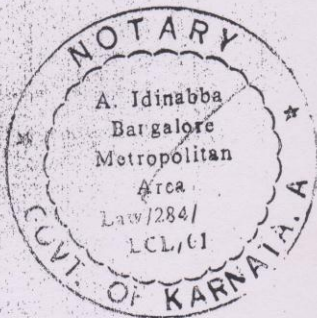
: I. a) The members of the Governing Body shall be the first members of the Society. The other members shall consist of those who are invited by the Governing Body, to become members of the Society and on their acceptance their names shall be entered in the register of members maintained by the Society. Such members of the Society shall have attained the age of 18. The members shall be fully professed Sisters of the Congregation of the Most Holy Saviour of St. Bridget, as defined in its constitution.

b) The Society shall take over the assets and liabilities of:

- i) Convent of St. Brigitta,

- ii) St. Bridget's Convent,
Nachanahalli,
Pallya P.O.,
Mysore - 570 008.
- iii) St. Bridget's Convent,

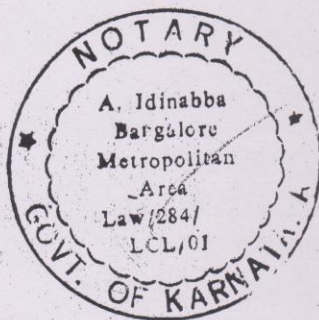
Bound by Memorandum
of Association Rules
and Regulations

II.

Every member of the Society shall be bound by the provisions of the Memorandum of Association of the Society and these Rules and Regulations and by all Rules and Regulations, Bye-laws, and decision from time to time made or taken by the Society in General Meeting or by the Governing Body.

III.

The property and income of the Society shall be applied towards the promotion of the objects of the Society as set forth in the memorandum of association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of bonus, dividend or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to the members of the Society provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment of any office or employees of the Society or other person for any service actually rendered or expenses previously authorised and actually incurred for the purpose of the Society.

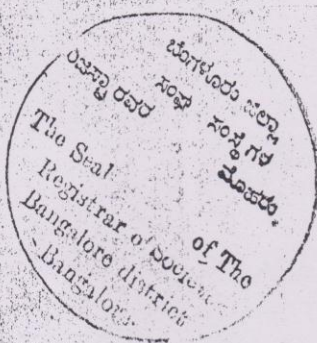

: IV.

Membership of the Society shall ipso facto terminate if :

- a) a member dies, or leaves or is excluded from the Society or perma-



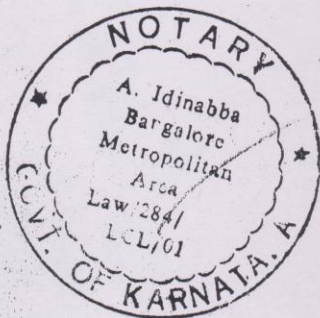

- c) membership is terminated as provided by these Rules and Regulations.

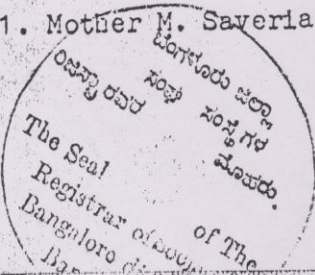
Governing Body : V.

The management and control of the Society shall be vested in a Governing Body consisting of not less than seven members, of whom the Provincial, the first Assistant, the Bursar and the Superior shall be the ex-officio members, who shall not be liable to retirement from the Governing Body, while they hold their respective offices. The other members of the Governing Body shall be elected at the annual General Meeting of the Society. Any vacancy occurring in the Governing Body, shall be filled by the Governing Body by the majority of votes, and the person so appointed shall hold office only until the next General Meeting of the Society; but the Governing Body shall have power to act notwithstanding any vacancy in its number.

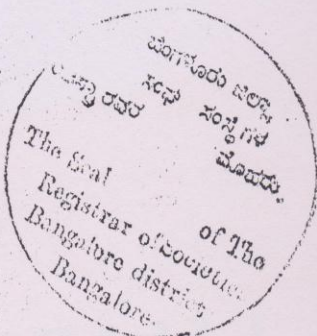
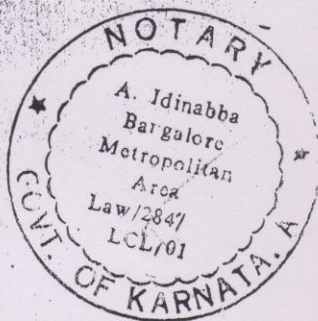

VII. The President and in her absence, the Vice President shall be the Chairman at all meetings of the Society and of the Governing Body. In the absence of both of them, the members of the Society or of the Governing Body, as the case may be, present at a Meeting may elect any other member of the Governing Body or failing such other member of the Society as Chairman of the meeting.

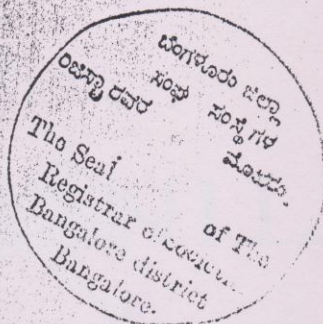
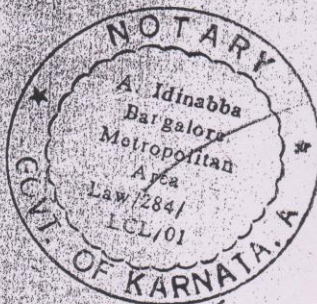

Powers of Governing Body

VIII. The Governing Body shall have the entire control and management of the business and affairs of the Society and shall have all such powers of the Society enabling them generally to carry out the objects of the Society as are by the Act required to be exercised or done by the Society in General Meeting. The Governing Body shall also have the powers from time to time to make, vary, repeal bye-laws for the transaction and regulation of the business and affairs both of the Society and of itself; but no bye-laws shall be made, varied or repealed by the Governing Body so as to conflict with or to revoke any subsisting objects made by the Society. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing powers, the Governing Body shall, for the promotion and realisation of the objects and purposes of the Society have the following powers, namely,

- a) To acquire immovable property of any tenure mainly in the State of Karnataka and also in any part of India, according to the needs of the Society may require with or without buildings and structures there by way of purchases absolutely or by way of lease, exchange gifts or in any other form of acquisition.

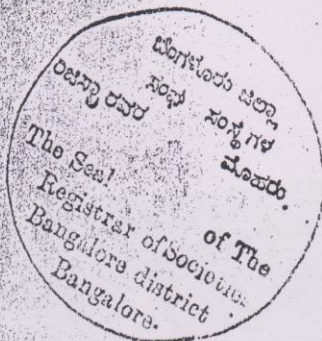

- b) To construct such building or buildings and structures as may be necessary and from time to time, to improve, alter or extent the same or any parts thereof and to equip the same with all such plants, machinery, instruments, apparatus, appliances, amenities and facilities as the Governing Body may deem fit.
- c) To employ, suspend, discharge and dismiss nurses, doctors, teachers, social workers, attendants and any other person or staff either for remuneration or gratuitously on such terms as the Governing Body may deem fit.
- d) To apply for, receive and utilise any Government, Municipal or other grants or allowances in connection with any institution, work, activity or property held or conducted by the Society or otherwise and to deal with the same according to the terms thereof.
- e) To solicit, receive, administer and use any gift, donations, subscriptions or foundation in kind or money or any other property, whether subject to any trust or not, for any of the objects of the Society and to undertake and carry out the offices, duties and functions of trustees, managers

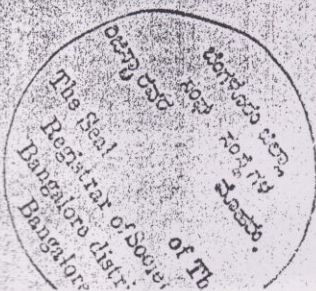

and administrators, either solely or jointly with another or others for or in respect of any gifts, donations, trusts foundations or property, whether vested in the Society or otherwise, notwithstanding that the carrying out of any such trusts may involve the exercise of powers not specifically mentioned therein.

- f) To invest and deal with the funds and monies of the Society in such securities under the Indian Trust Act and under Sec.13 (1) (d) r/ws 13(5) of the Income-Tax, Act 1961.
- g) To negotiate, and enter into any arrangement with any Government, State, University, Municipality or any other public or private authority, Body or association, which may seem beneficial or conducive to any other Society.
- h) To borrow or receive money on deposit upon terms and with or without security on all or any of the property and assets of the Society, present or future, as the Governing Body shall deem necessary or expedient.
- i) To deposit moneys in any Bank or Banks, either in Saving or Current Accounts, Fixed Deposits, or accounts or any other description and to withdraw such moneys from time to time or any time, on such terms and in such manner as the Governing Body may see fit.
- j) To draw, endorse, discount, and in general deal with bills of exchange, promissory notes, cheques, bills of lading, railway receipts, registered or insured letters, warrants, bonds,

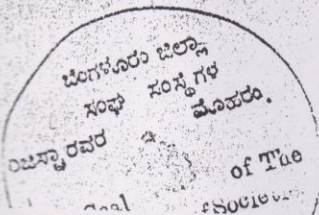
debentures, Government, Municipal or port Trust, Loan Notes, stocks and shares, parcels, postal receipts, savings certificates, Dock warrants and other negotiable, commercial or transferable instruments or securities.

k) To subscribe to or otherwise aid medical, educational, cultural, technical or other institutions or objects of a public character, which have a moral or other claim to support or aid from the Society by reason of the locality of their operations or otherwise.

l) To provide for the maintenance and welfare of the persons employed by or sponsored with the Society by establishing and contributing to Provident and Benefit Funds and by giving pensions, or otherwise as the Governing Body may deem fit, and this maintenance expenditure shall not be constructed as a division or distribution of profits, income or dividends to the members.

m) To maintain a Repair Fund to meet the expenses of a capital nature and pay into such fund money at such terms and in such amounts as the Governing Body may from time to time decide.

n) To establish and maintain a Reserve Fund/ Endowment Fund such amount as the Governing Body may think fit, for the promotion of the activities of the Society, including the maintenance and support of the members



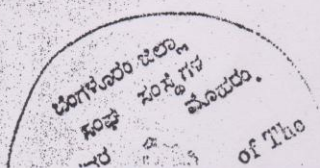

of the Society and the training of personnel for the purpose of the Society.

- o) To establish, maintain, or close down branches or representations of the Society in such places in India and on such terms as the Governing Body may from time to time deem necessary or expedient.
- p) To enter into and carry out arrangement, for joint working, or for amalgamation with any other association, Society or institution having objects within or similar to the objects of the Society.
- q) To appoint such person or persons as the Governing Body may deem fit, for the purpose of representing the Society and/or the Governing Body in any legal or other proceedings to be instituted by or against the Society and/or the Governing Body.
- r) To appoint, remove and delegate all or any of the powers of the Governing Body to such Committee or Committees consisting of such member or members of the Governing Body and/or another or others as the Governing Body may from time to time deem necessary or expedient.



Arbitration : IX. In the event of any difference of opinion among the members of the Governing Body or any matter, such matter shall be decided by majority of votes and this decision shall be final and accepted by the Governing Body.

Signing of Documents Trustees : X.

The President of the Society in whom all the property and funds of the Society shall vest and they, and in the absence from Bangalore or any of them such other member of the Governing Body as may be appointed by the Governing Body in her place, and stead, shall on behalf of the Society make, sign and complete all contracts, licences, transfer and other documents to purchase, take on lease or hire or otherwise acquire, dispose of or otherwise deal with any movable or immovable property, of all descriptions for and on behalf of the Society, provided that the Governing Body shall have power at any time or times by resolution to authorise any two or one of such Trustees to act and exercise the aforesaid powers for and on behalf of all three Trustees.

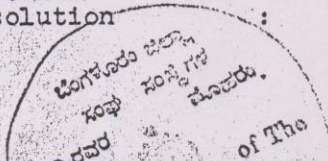
Meeting and Quorum of Governing Body : XI.



Meeting of the Governing Body shall be held at such times and places as the President or Secretary may from time to time determine. A quorum for a meeting of the Governing Body shall be three members generally present (unless the Governing Body otherwise decide).

If the meeting is adjourned for want of quorum, no quorum will be necessary for the adjourned meeting.

Circular Resolution : XII.



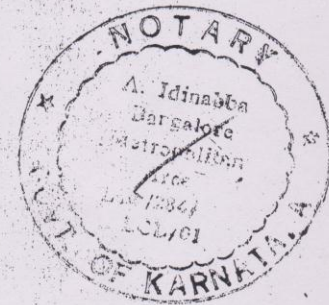
A circular resolution issued by the President on any subject which she deems urgent

and signed by the majority of the members of the Governing Body, shall in all respects be as valid and binding as a resolution passed at a meeting of the Governing Body, duly convened and constituted and such resolution shall not be deemed invalid by reason of want of notice or any other cause whatsoever.

Annual General Meeting :

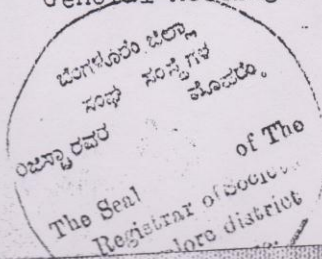
XIII. The Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be held in the month of January or as near thereto as possible in each year at such time and place as the President may determine for the following purposes:

- a) To receive the report of the Governing Body, the accounts of the Society and its Auditor's Report for the year ending on 31st December next proceeding the date of the Meeting. Such accounts comprise of a balance sheet and statement of receipt disbursement of the said year.
- b) To elect the eligible members of the Governing Body for the ensuing year.
- c) To appoint an Auditor or Auditors and to fix her or their remuneration.
- d) To transact any other business, which may be brought forward by any member of the Governing Body or of the Society with the previous permission of the Chairman.



Extraordinary General Meeting :

XIV. The Governing Body may call an Extraordinary General Meeting of the Society whenever in their opinion they may deem fit necessary to do so.



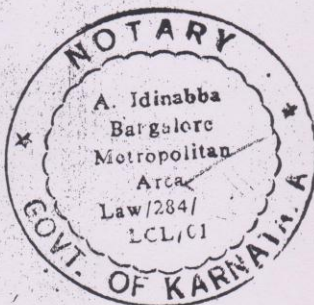

XXV. For all things and matters which have not been specifically provided for hereinabove, the provisions of the Karnataka Societies Registration Act, 1960 and the Rules made thereunder, shall apply.

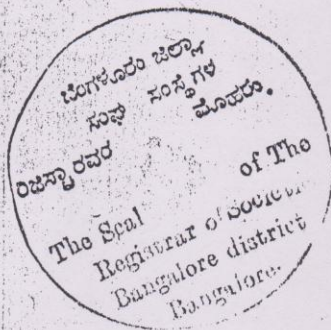

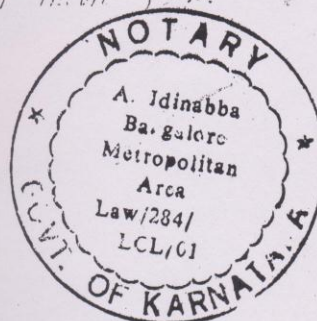

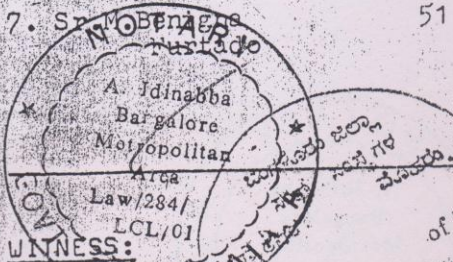
